- ◆ has existed since the re-drawing of the Danish-German border in 1920.
- ◆ includes approximately 15,000 members in Southern Denmark.
- ◆ functions as a vital bridge between the German and Danish cultures and promotes the historically German identity of its members as well as their German language.
- ◆ contributes to the diversity of the Danish-German border region.
- ◆ cares for 600 children in 21 pre-schools and educates 1.400 children in 16 general schools and one Gymnasium.
- ◆ maintains German libraries in five cities.
- ◆ publishes the daily Der Nordschleswiger.
- ◆ is politically represented through the Schleswigsche Partei.
- ◆ offers many activities in the realms of church, culture, sports, social services and leisure.
